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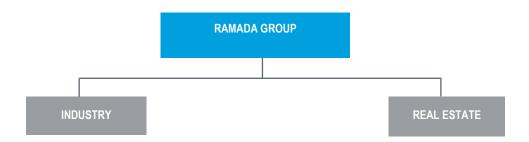
#### To the Shareholders

Pursuant to the legal requirements, the Board of Directors of Ramada Investimentos e Indústria, S.A. ("Ramada Investimentos", "Company" or "Ramada Group") hereby presents its Director's Report for the first semester of 2018.

# INTRODUCTION

Ramada Investimentos<sup>1</sup> is the parent company of a group of companies ("Ramada Group") that operate in two business areas:

- i) Industry, which includes the activity of special steels and wire drawing, as well as the activity related to the management of financial investments in which the Group is a minority shareholder;
- ii) Real Estate, focused in the management of real estate assets;



In the last quarter of 2017, Ramada Investimentos acquired, indirect control of 99% of the share capital of SOCITREL – Sociedade Industrial de Trefilaria, S.A. ("Socitrel"). It should be noted that Socitrel only started to impact the consolidated statement of profit and loss from January 1st 2018 onwards. Additionally, in the period ended March 31, 2018 Ramada Investimentos purchased the remaining 1% of participation regarding Socitrel share capital.

This acquisition allowed Ramada Investimentos to diversify its industrial activity, entering a new area of business. The main business of Socitrel is related with manufacture of steel wires, capable of being used in a wide variety of activities, including industry, agriculture and construction.

In the first half of 2018, Ramada Investimentos sold the entire share capital of Ramada Storax, S.A. and of all its subsidiaries in France, United Kingdom, Belgium and Spain, which supported the entire international distribution network. This operation imply the discontinuation of the Storage Solutions activity.

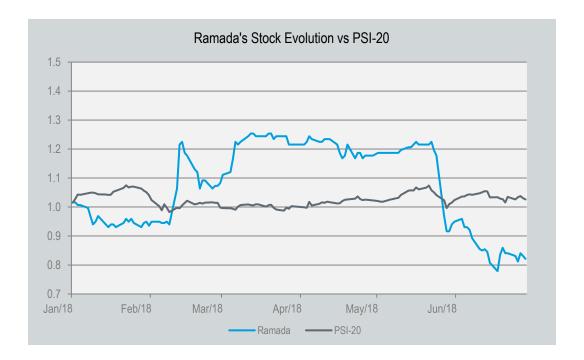


# STOCK EXCHANGE EVOLUTION

(Note: in order to enable a better comparison of the stock fluctuations, the PSI 20 index has been consider as being equal in value to the opening price of the shares.)

In the first half of 2018, the Portuguese stock market index (PSI-20) appreciated 2.60% in relation to the end of 2017.

The Ramada Group shares devalued 17.85% over the same period, presenting a lower performance than the reference index in this period.



At the end of the first semester of 2018, Ramada Group shares closed at 8.65 Euro per share, which represents a market capitalization of 222 Million Euro.

In the first semester of 2018, Ramada Group shares were trade at a maximum price of 13.20 Euro per share and a minimum price of 8.20 Euro per share. In the same period, were trade 2,137,348 shares of the Ramada Group.

# Ramada Group share price evolution

The main events that marked the evolution of Ramada Group share price during the first semester of 2018 can be describe as follows:





- In the announcement of the Group's performance for the financial year 2017, released on 8 March 2018, Ramada's consolidated net profit was of 56.7 million Euro, which represents an increase of 307.2% over the previous year. The total revenues amounted to 158.2 million Euro and consolidated EBITDA amounted approximately to 24.8 million Euro. On that date the shares closed at 10.53 Euros per share;
- In the announcement made on 20 March 2018, Ramada Investimentos reported the sale of subsidiary Ramada Storax, S.A..
- In the announcement made on 10 May, Ramada Investimentos informed the market that dividends related with net profit oh of 2017, corresponding to 2.23 Euro per share, would be paid from 30 May;
- On 30 May 2018, in the announcement concerning the presentation of the financial statements for the first quarter of 2018, Ramada Group presented a net profit of 3.3 million Euro, consolidated EBITDA amounted to 4.7 million Euro, while total turnover amounted to 31.8 million Euro.



# **GROUP'S ACTIVITY**

Ramada Investimentos, S.A. is the parent company of a group of companies ("Ramada Group") which, together, operate in two business areas:

- i) Industry, which includes the activity of special steels and wire drawing, as well as the activity related to the management of financial investments in which the Group is a minority shareholder
- ii) Real Estate, focused in the management of real estate assets.

The steel produts sold by the Group is mainly used for the construction of machinery and its components and for the production of tools (dies, cuttings and molds), with the main markets being the mold making industry for plastic components on automotive sector, equipment and components for electrical appliances and electronics.

Socitrel (company acquired by the group in the final of 2017) is dedicated to the manufacture and commercialization of steel wire, for application in the most diverse areas of activity, namely industry, agriculture and civil construction.

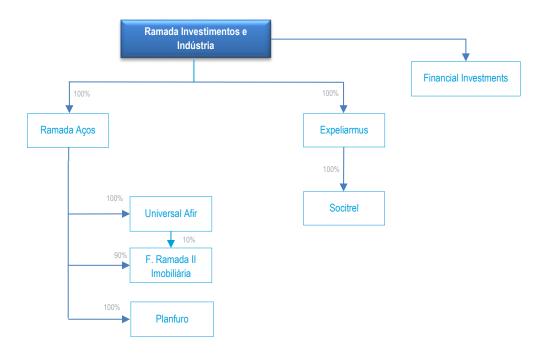
On 30 June 2018, the participation of the Group in CEV / Converde assumes relevance in the activity of management of financial investments, among others.

The activity of CEV / Converde consists in the development and patent register focused on BLAD protein. The BLAD is a fungicide obtained from the extraction of the protein from Lupinus Albus (sweet lupines).

The Real Estate segment includes real estate management activity (composed of forest assets and real estate of the group) and is developed by F. Ramada II - Imobiliária, S.A.



The structure of Ramada Group, as of 30 June 2018, can be present as follows:



In the first half of 2018, the Steel business recorded a growth in turnover compared to the same period of the previous year.

The sectors of mold and metal mechanics continue to be the engine of sales growth of this activity.

The recent EU, China and EU trade battle can bring huge upheavals in car sales, although the imperative need to reduce vehicle weight and the introduction of the "electric and self-powered car" will have a significant impact on the activity of the Molds Industry.

In the first half of 2018, the Group took another important step in entering a new niche market in this sector: molds for bumpers, wheel arches and door panels.

The Metal-mechanics sector continues to go through a good period with exports making an important contribution.

The sector of the construction of tools for the stamping of parts for the automotive industry had a dynamic first half of the year, with new projects awarded to the Portuguese market, which boosted our oxyfuel service and sales of cold work steels.

Steel prices continue to rise and everything suggests that this trend will continue until the end of the year.

The Steel business operates essentially in the domestic market, which accounted for 94% of turnover in the first half months of 2018. The growth of exports is a bet for 2018. The rise in exports has posed enormous challenges to the Group's logistics, so far dedicated to the domestic market.



In the first half of 2018, Socitrel's activity registered a significant growth compared to the same period of 2017, recovering levels of production, sales and financial performance.

In the main markets where Socitrel operates, there is some stability at the end of the first half with pressure signals on the supply side, after a few months of demand-side pressure. At the level of the zinc products the supply side pressure remains. The Machine Wire market maintains the price stability associated with the uncertainty of its evolution for the third quarter.

Socitrel operates mainly in the foreign market, which in the first half of 2018 accounted for 66% of turnover, with Europe being the target market with the highest preponderance.



## FINANCIAL REVIEW

The financial information presented below in relation to Ramada Group was prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement criteria of the International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS), as adopted by the European Union.

The income statement for the first half of 2017 was restated in order to segregate in an autonomous line the results attributable to the discontinuing units (subsidiaries that are dedicate to the storage solutions business).

The main indicators of the consolidated activity of the Ramada Group can be summarize as follows:

Total turnover of Ramada Group, during the first semester of 2018, amounted to 67,774 thousand Euro representing an increase of 73.1% compared to the total turnover of the homologous period in 2017. This growth is explained by the impact of the consolidation of the Socitrel subsidiary only in 2018. Excluding this effect, the group had an equivalent growth in the period of 5,482 thousand Euros, an increase of 14.1%.

Total costs, excluding amortization, financial expenses and taxes, amounted to 58,002 thousand Euro, representing an increase of 86.9 % in relation to June 2017.

EBITDA in the first semester of 2018 reached 9,772 thousand Euro, representing an increase of 20.6% when compared to the homologous period. The EBITDA margin reached 14.4%, which compares to 16.7% obtained in the same period in 2017.

Group's operating results (EBIT) amounted to 6,774 thousand Euro, representing a positive variation of 22.4% comparing with 5,535 thousand Euro in the same period of 2017.

The negative financial costs amounted to 893 thousand Euro, representing a growth of 34.3%, when compared with the same period in 2017.

In the first semester of 2018 net income from continuing operations amounted to 4,511 thousand Euro, 1.5% less than in the first semester of the previous year.

The net result of the discontinued operations was 60,214 thousand Euros, which included the gain on the transaction of the entire Storage Solutions business of 59,038 thousand Euros. In the same period of 2017 the results of this activity amounted to 2,493 thousand Euros.

Consolidated net income, including discontinued operations, reached 64,725 thousand Euros, and 7,701 thousand Euros in the same period of 2017.

During the first semester of 2018 the total income for the industry segment amounted to 64,323 thousand Euro, representing an increase of 80% compared to total income for the first three months of 2017. This increase is explained by the impact of the consolidation of the Socitrel subsidiary, only in 2018. Excluding this effect, the group had an equivalent growth in the period of 5,482 thousand Euros, an increase of 14.1%.

Industry segment's EBITDA in the first semester of 2018 amounted to 6.993 thousand Euro, which represents an increase of 32,8% when compared with 5.266 thousand Euro achieved in the same period in 2017. The industry EBITDA margin decreased to 10.9% compared to 13.6% in the previous year.

Operating income (EBIT), in the amount of 4,118 thousand Euros, grew by 42.1% compared to 2,898 thousand Euros in the same period of 2017.

Total income for the Real Estate segment in the first semester of 2018 was 3,450 thousand Euro, verifying an increase of 1.4% over the same period of 2017.

The rents obtained from the long-term lease of forestland represent more than 95% of total income of the Real Estate segment.

Real Estate segment EBITDA in the first semester of 2018 amounted to 2,779 thousand Euro, having registered a decrease of 2.0% compared to 2017.

In the first half of 2018, the operating income (EBIT) of the Real Estate segment, in the amount of 2,656 thousand Euros, showed a slight increase compared to the same period of 2017.

The financial results of the Real Estate segment were negative by 436 thousand Euros, showing an improvement of 19.5% compared to the negative 542 thousand Euros in the first half of 2017.

In the first half of 2018, pre-tax income from the Real Estate segment amounted to 2,220 thousand Euros, 5.9% higher than in 2017.



## **INVESTMENTS AND DEBT**

Ramada Group investments (CAPEX) in the first semester of 2018 amounted to 1,141 thousand Euro.

On June 30, 2018, the Ramada Group had net cash, in the amount of 12,035 thousand Euros. At 31 December 2017, the net nominal indebtedness amounted to 7,872 thousand Euros.



# SECOND SEMESTER OUTLOOK

Taking into account the situation that the mold and metal-mechanic sectors are currently experiencing and the positive developments that have been taking place in Socitrel, the Group expected to reach a good level of activity in the second half of 2018.



# **CORPORATE GOVERNANCE**

In accordance with the current legislation, the Group is not required to provide information regarding corporate governance, since this information is only compulsory together with the annual management report. # 1. INTRODUCTORY NOTE

RAMADA INVESTIMENTOS E INDÚSTRIA, S.A. ("Ramada Investimentos", "Ramada Group" or "Group") is a public limited company incorporated on June 1, 2008, located at Rua General Norton de Matos, 68, r / c in Oporto. Its main activity consists on management consulting services, and its shares are listed on Euronext Lisbon. In June 2018 F. Ramada - Investimentos SGPS, S.A., changed its corporate purpose and its name to "RAMADA INVESTIMENTOS E INDÚSTRIA, S.A.

The Ramada Group was created as a result of the reorganization process of Altri, SGPS, S.A. through the demerger of the business areas of steel and storage systems, namely the participation held in Ramada Aços S.A., which represented the voting rights of the mentioned company. The restructuring involved a simple demerger operation, as predicted in item 1.a), article 118, of the Portuguese Companies Act ("Código das Sociedades Comerciais").

Following this process, the share of the assets of Altri, SGPS, SA corresponding to the shareholding management business in the steel and storage solutions sector, including all other resources (notably persons, assets and liabilities) were transfer to Ramada Investimentos.

Currently, Ramada Investimentos is the parent company of a group of companies listed in Note 4 (designated as Ramada Group), that together operate two distinct business segments: i) Industry Segment, which includes the activity of special steels and wire drawing, as well as the activity related to the management of financial investments in which the Group is a minority shareholder; and ii) Real Estate Segment, aimed at the management of real estate assets.

The consolidated financial statements of Ramada Group are present in Euro (rounded to units), which is the currency used by the Group in its operations and, therefore, is consider its functional currency. The operations of the foreign companies whose functional currency is different from Euro are included in the consolidated financial statements in accordance with the policy set out in note 2.

### 2. MAIN ACCOUNTING POLICIES AND BASIS OF PRESENTATION

The consolidated financial statements as of 30 June 2018 were prepared in accordance with the accounting policies defined by the International Financial Reporting Standards and in accordance with IAS 34 – Interim Financial Reporting, and include the statement of financial position, the income statement, the statement of comprehensive income, the statement of changes in equity and the statement of cash flows, as well as selected notes to the financial statements.

The accounting policies adopted in the preparation of the consolidated financial statements of F. Ramada are consistent with the accounting policies used in the preparation of the financial statements presented for the year ended as of 31 December 2017 except for the adoption of the new standards effective at 1 January 2018. There were no significant impacts from IFRS 9 and IFRS 15 application.

# 3. CHANGES IN ACCOUNTING POLICIES AND CORRECTION OF ERRORS

During the reporting period, there were no changes in the accounting policies and were not identified any material mistakes related with previous periods.

# 5. DISCONTINUED OPERATIONS

On 20 March 2018, the Ramada Group reached an agreement with the Averys Group for the disposal of the entire share capital of its wholly-owned subsidiary, Ramada Storax, S.A. ("Storax").

The execution of the transaction was subject to prior notification to the Competition Authority, under the terms established in the legal system of competition and, for this reason, conditional to the decision of non-opposition of that entity. On May 4, 2018, the Competition Authority notified the non-opposition to the referred transaction.

Storax is a company which, together with its four wholly-owned subsidiaries - Storax, SARL (France), Storax Limited (UK), Storax Benelux (Belgium) and Storax España is dedicated to storage solutions.

The leased land generated, during the six months period ended as of June 30, 2018, income amounting, to approximately, 3,129,996 Euro (approximately 6,331,825 Euro in the end of 2017).

The minimum future receipts for leases of forest land amounting, to approximately, 6.6 million Euros in each of the following 5 years. After this period and until the end of the contracts, the minimum future receipts total, approximately 33 million Euros. The rents provided for in each lease are updated at the end of each 2-year period, starting from the beginning of the civil year immediately following the signature of the contract, based on the consumer price index.

Given the land characteristics (land leased to third parties for forestry activity), frequent market transactions comparable for this type of assets do not occur. Accordingly, the Board of Directors considers that it is not possible to reliably estimate the fair value of the land, and, as such, it is recorded at acquisition cost. However, it is the Board of Directors belief that, given the amount of rents collected annually, the market value of these assets will not be significantly different from its book value.

## 7. INCOME TAXES

In accordance with current legislation, the tax returns are subject to review and correction by the tax authorities over a period of four years (five years for Social Security), except when tax losses have occurred, tax benefits have been granted, or inspections, complaints or disputes are on-going. In these cases, depending on the circumstances, the above referred period deadlines can be extended or suspended. Therefore, the tax returns of F. Ramada and its subsidiaries for the years 2014 to 2017 may still be subject to review.

The Board of Directors of F. Ramada believes that any potential corrections arising from reviews/inspections of these tax returns by the tax authorities will not have a significant effect on the consolidated financial statements as of June 30, 2018.
